

Part of the community




We put together a plan to make sure this happens.

- Work on the Northern Beaches
- Visit the Northern Beaches



We found out that some groups of people need more support.

We call them **priority groups**.

Safe



People feel safe when

No one hurts them

 They do not worry that someone might hurt them.



Sometimes people and places can make you feel unsafe.

- Can get help when they need it
- Can get mental health support within 1 week.

Included



To be included means that you are part of the community.

Has a say


• Can find the support they need.



We will build community hubs.


A **community hub** is a place where you can go to and get the support you need.


This could be support for things like health, housing or counselling.

This could be family, friends or other people in the community.




We will work hard to make sure that

We will do a survey every 2 years.

The survey is to find out how things are going.
